

# Biblical Timeline of Man (drawn to scale)

I developed this scaled-timeline because a picture is worth a thousand words. It attempts to put in perspective God's ultimate plan and control over the earth. Obviously, not everything is included but I tried to focus on **God's relationship with Satan, Israel, Christians, and Muslims**, because that's what it's all about.

*"For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms." (Ephesians 6:12)*

1. My interpretations of [Daniel 11](#) and the [Seals](#) are unique and original, and show how God's prophecies fill in the last 2000-years, so God's timeline is *continuous*.
  - a. The *correct meaning* of Daniel 11 describes Islam, which falls in the range of Satan's "revenge" (Rev 12).
  - b. Jeremiah prophesied that Israel would be scattered and re-assembled. ([Jeremiah 16:14-15](#)) Yet, only the *correct meaning* of the Seals reveal 'how' God planned to accomplish that. (revolts - money - Holocaust) [Seals 2-4]
2. Another interesting fact is that Noah's life-span over-lapped with Abraham's by 58 years! And Shem actually out-lived Abraham by 35 years! (math below) My point is: Even before it was written, God's creation and flood story could have been passed to Abraham by someone who was actually on the Ark.

## Timeline adjustment

I recently noticed the verse in 1<sup>st</sup> Kings (below) that links the Exodus to Solomon's reign, which I had overlooked before.

### **1 Kings 6:1**

"In the **four hundred and eightieth year** after the Israelites had **come out of Egypt**, in the **fourth year of Solomon's reign** over Israel, in the month of Ziv, the second month, he began to build the temple of the LORD."

### **Exodus 12:40-41**

"Now the length of time the Israelite people **lived in Egypt** was **430 years**. At the end of the 430 years, to the very day, all the LORD's divisions left Egypt."

Previously, I had started subtracting from 4000 BC because I didn't realize that you could connect Adam to more accurate record keeping. However, 'Assyrian king records' pinpoint David's reign as 1010 – 970 BC (based on the death of Ahab), which means that the 4<sup>th</sup> year of Solomon's reign (mentioned in the verse) was 966 BC, putting the Exodus at 1446 BC (480 years earlier), and Jacob's move to Egypt at 1876 BC (430 years earlier). Therefore, I had to move the starting point (Adam's birth) to 4114 BC to make the dates coincide.

I realize that the Jews currently have the Hebrew calendar on year 5780, which is when they think mankind began, but the Bible shows that it was actually about 6110 years ago. I don't know where they get their figures because the above verses, together with all the various individual ages, especially that Jacob was 130-years old when he went to Egypt (Gen 47:9) make a complete timeline, which can be coordinated with ancient Assyrian records.

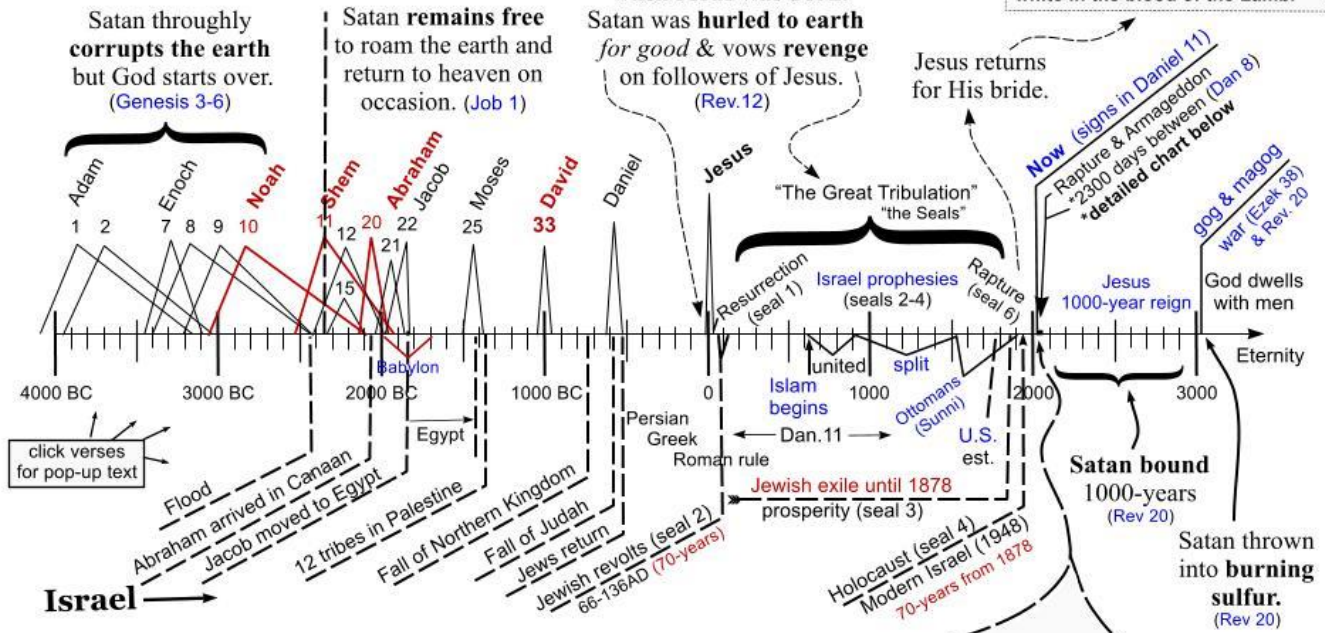
I also realize that the 114-year adjustment affects the overall 7000-year timeline of man, but I think the 6+1 'days' (1000-years each) is still valid because I think Peter's statement about 'a day being like a 1000-years', and vice-versa, was a general approximation anyway.

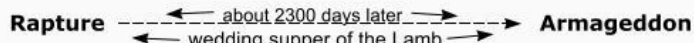

(\*a rare time when 'many' humans will occupy heaven and earth at the same time)

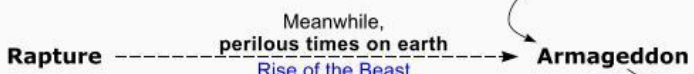


**Revelation 7:9**
